Monterey Launches Commercial Avenue Complete Streets Plan; Survey Open for Input

Monterey, TN- With a grant from the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT), the Town of Monterey has initiated the development of a Complete Streets Plan focused on improving mobility, connectivity, and safety along Commercial Ave from S. Poplar St. to Crossville St.

An online survey is available to gather community experiences and opinions. The survey can be accessed on the town's website, social media pages, and in-person at the Depot Museum on Mondays-Fridays from 8am-4pm or Saturdays from 9am-2pm. Residents are encouraged to complete the survey to provide their insights on transportation challenges, priorities, and desired improvements. The town will also be hosting a public open house in October. Stay tuned for more details.

Monterey aims to create a street with safe and accessible transportation options for everyone in the community.
